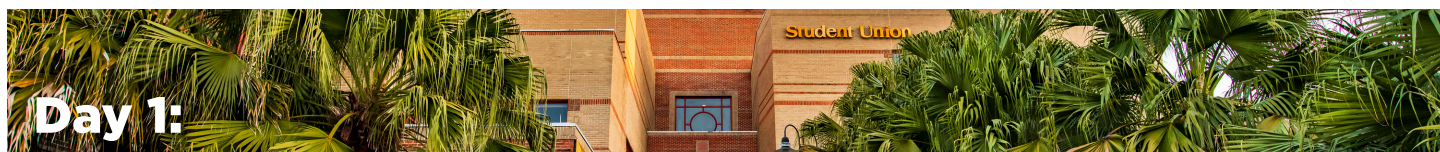

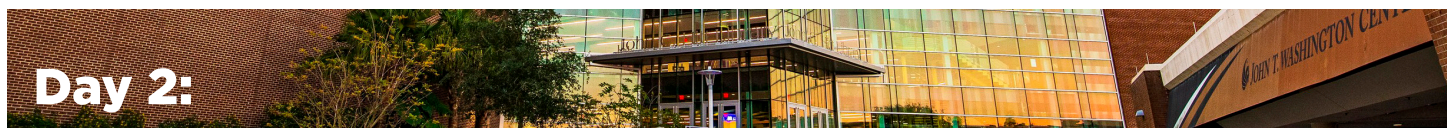
# Orientation

8:15am-9:00am	<b>Check-In</b> Student Union <i>Pegasus Ballroom</i> <i>Pre-Function</i>	Let's start your Orientation with some excitement! First, students and families will check-in with our Orientation Leader student staff. Then enjoy breakfast while we get the day started.
8:15am-9:00am	<b>Breakfast</b> Student Union <i>Pegasus Ballroom</i>	After checking in, enjoy breakfast on us! Breakfast will be provided by UCF Dining Services.
