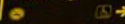

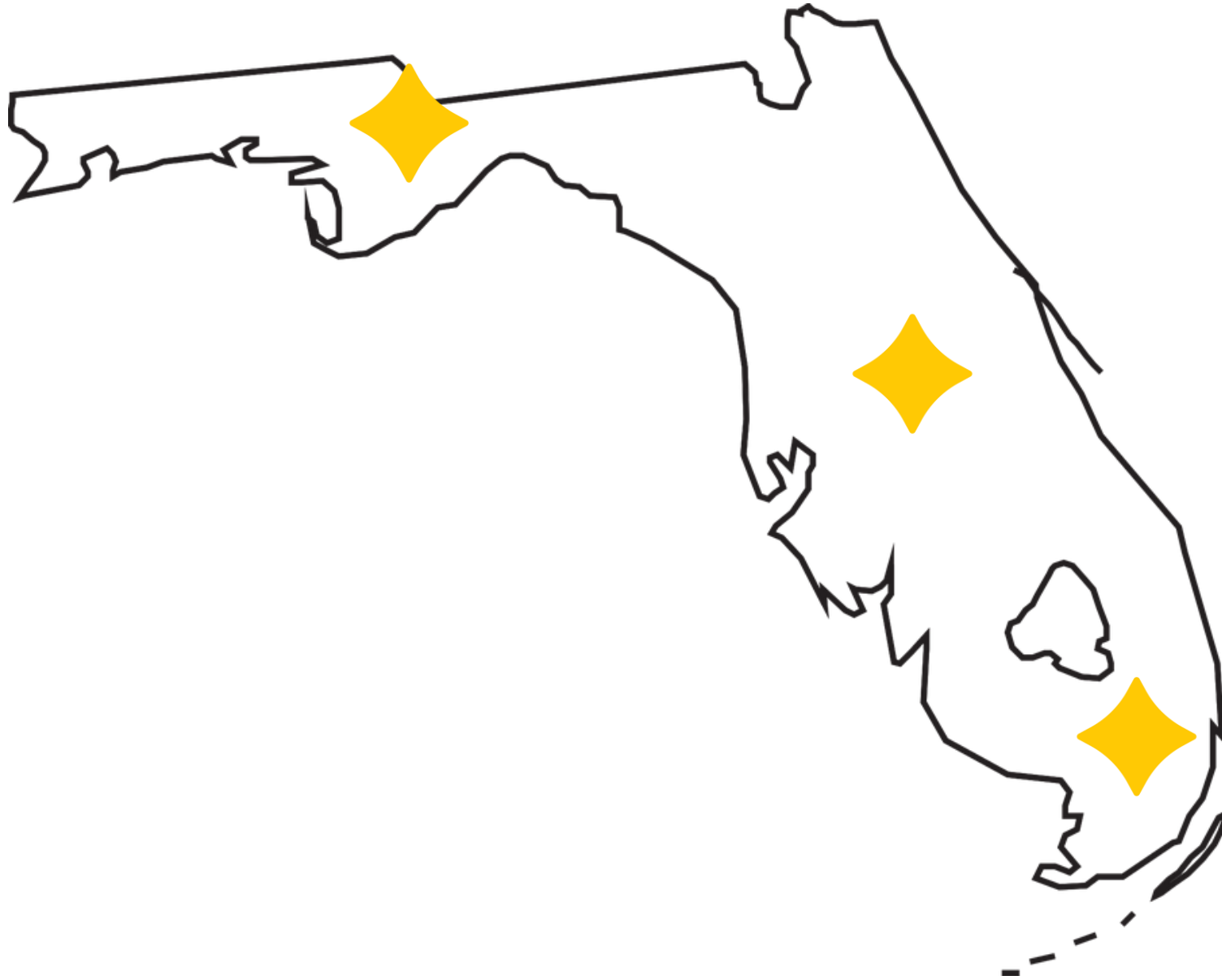

- *The estimated cost of an extra year of school can exceed \$100,000 a year when factoring in the cost to attend **and** lost wages in the fifth year*



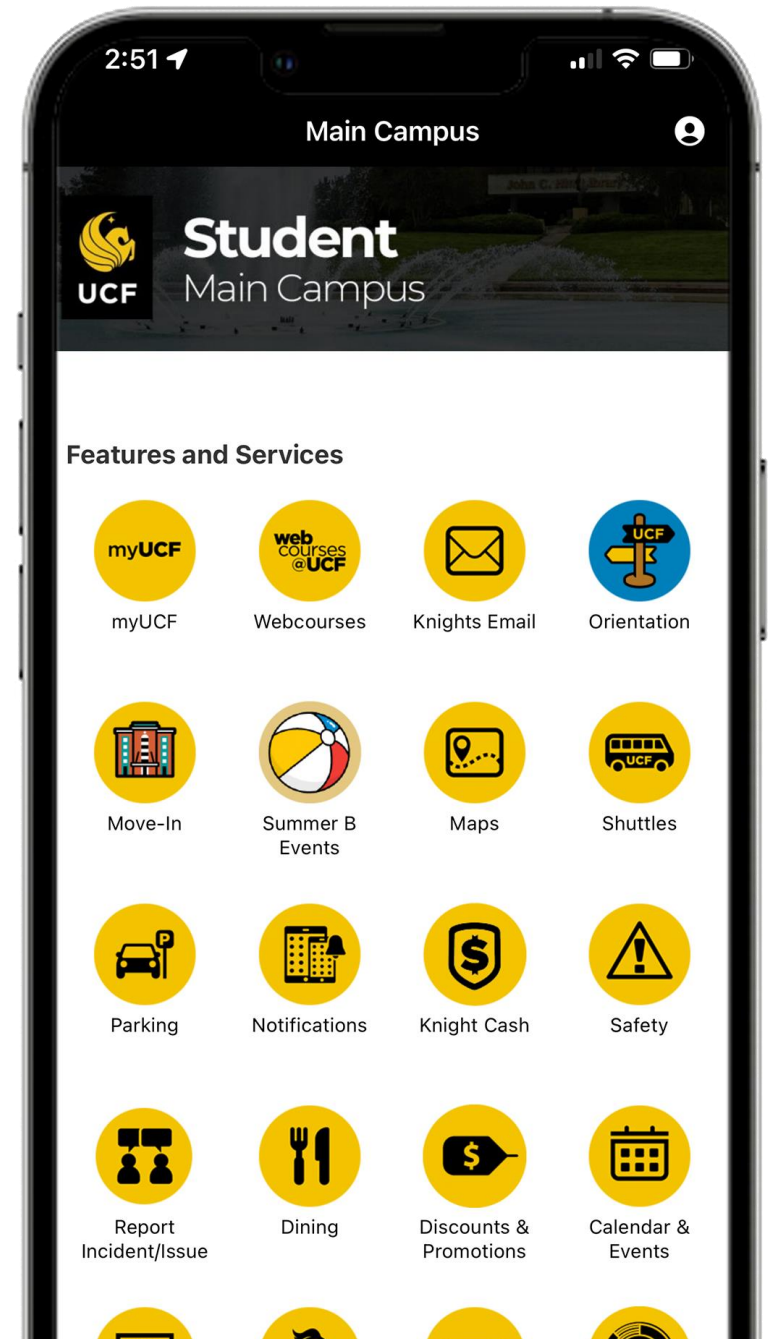
