


Where You Are In the Process

- Roommate Matching and Room Selection are complete!

 - Prepare for payment due same day as tuition
 - If you are on the waitlist we suggest looking for off-campus

housing at this time. There is no guarantee that you will receive a spot on-campus.

Move-In Tips

- Arrive at your selected appointment time NOT EARLIER ©
- Bring your own move-in equipment
- Review the parking maps on our website to understand unloading zones and long-term parking for each community
- Must have your UCF ID and additional photo ID to move in!




UCF Off-Campus Shuttles

Need to get to campus? There are 15 <u>UCF Off-Campus Shuttle</u> routes to get you there.








Shuttle Stops

- PARKING.UCF.EDU/SHUTTLES
 - 15 regular, fixed shuttle routes
 between campus and 22 off-campus
 apartments
 - Shuttles run from 6:30am -10:00pm
 - Ends at 8:00pm on Fridays
 - Do not run when classes aren't in session
- Many complexes have their own shuttles!
