Florida Prepaid Tuition

- You are not required to notify our office that you want to use your Prepaid plan. Our billing system links to Florida Prepaid with your SSN.
- Your Florida Prepaid will reflect on your fee invoice by the first day of classes.
 - If your Florida Prepaid is not showing prior to the Payment Deadline, please contact Student Account Services for assistance at <u>tpbilling@ucf.edu</u>
- UCF will automatically bill Florida Prepaid for the number of hours in which the student is enrolled.
 - Students wanting to cancel or adjust billings for a specific term must update the hours to bill in their myUCF prior to the end of the term's add/drop period. For instructions, please visit https://studentaccounts.ucf.edu/florida-prepaid/
- Fees not covered by the plan must be paid out of pocket or covered by other sources.

Payment Plan

- Available in myUCF portal
- Link to opt in is available at the beginning of the second week of classes
- There is a \$15.00 mandatory processing fee
- 50% of total tuition and fees is due upfront
- Students with financial aid, Florida Prepaid, waivers or third-party payments are NOT eligible for the plan.

Payment Deadline

- The payment deadline date is published on the **Academic Calendar** online at calendar.ucf.edu.
- The tuition and fee payment deadline is also posted to the student's <u>Fee Invoice</u> in the **myUCF** portal (*Student Self Service* > *Student Accounts* > *Fee Invoice*).
- Students with an authorized <u>deferral</u> may see the due date on the fee invoice adjusted after the term's add/drop period.
- *Late Payment Fee: \$100.00 (If not paid by the fee payment deadline listed on your Fee Invoice)
 - Additional penalties may be applied for reinstatement, if Dropped for Non-Payment



Refunds

Direct Deposit (highly recommended)

- Student's bank account; any U.S. financial institution
- Student's name must be on the account
- Student must sign up on myUCF (2-part process)
 - Student Self Service >Student Center >Student Direct Deposit


Applying For/ Transferring Financial Aid

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Required for most federal, state and institutional aid
- FAFSA is available each year on December 1.
- UPDATE the FAFSA to include our school code, 003954.
- Select the appropriate school year
- UCF's priority filing date is February 15!

Types of Financial Assistance

GRANTS: Pell, SEOG, FSAG, UCF GRANT

- Need-based
- LOANS: Stafford, Perkins, Parent PLUS
 - Need-based and non-need based
- WORK STUDY:
 - Need-based work program
- SCHOLARSHIPS: Bright Futures, Private, Institutional
 - Need based, and non-need based



Florida Bright Futures

- Update the postsecondary institution selection on the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), to UCF's State School Code: 481
- Florida Academic Scholars Award 100% of tuition and applicable fees
- Medallion Scholars Award 75% of tuition and applicable fees.
- Both can assist during summer semester
 - Minimum hour requirement: six (6)







Short Term Advance For Books


- The application is available on the website


