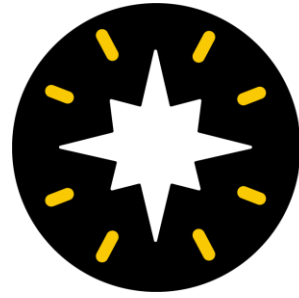

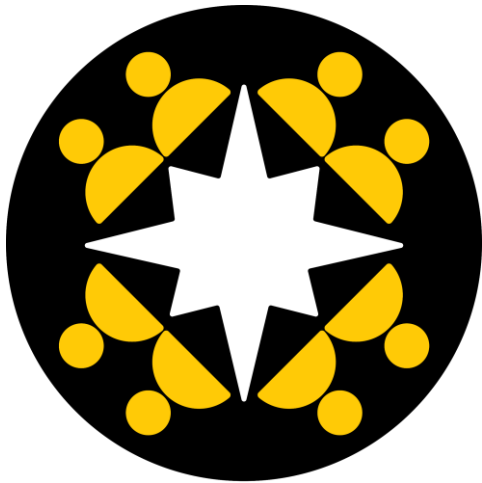
# Student Success

Most undergraduate degree programs at UCF require 120 credit hours. If you plan ahead, **complete at least 30 credit hours a year**, and stay on track, you'll **graduate in four years or less!**

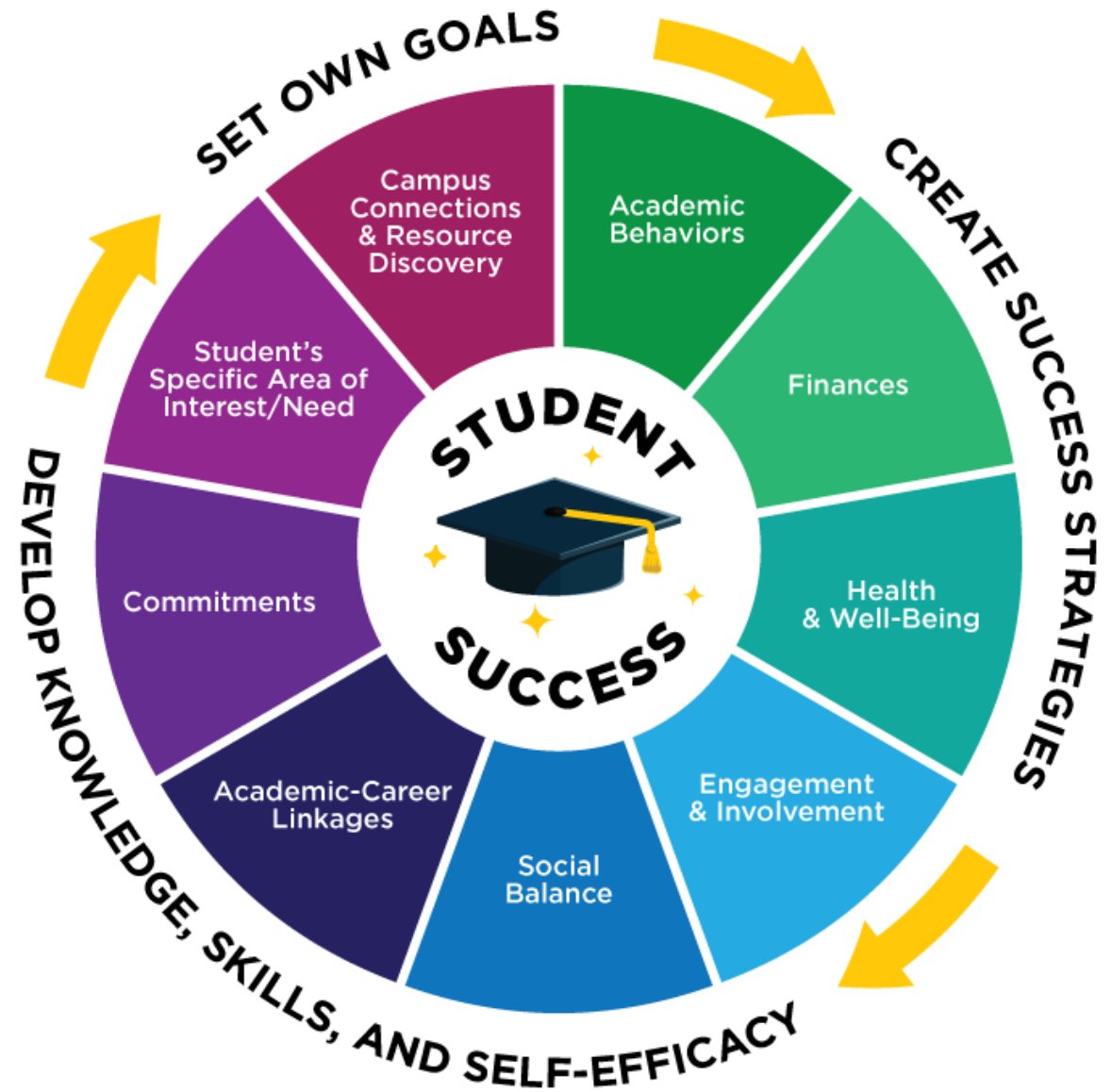

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# Academic Advocates

- Outreach to students in need

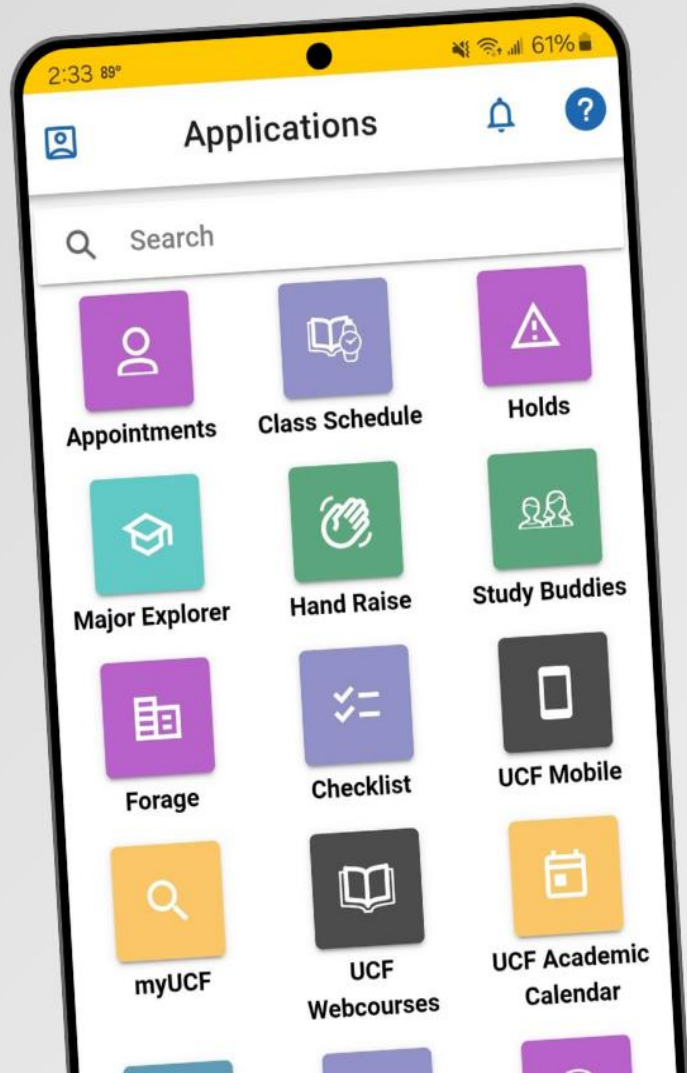


# MyKnight STAR
