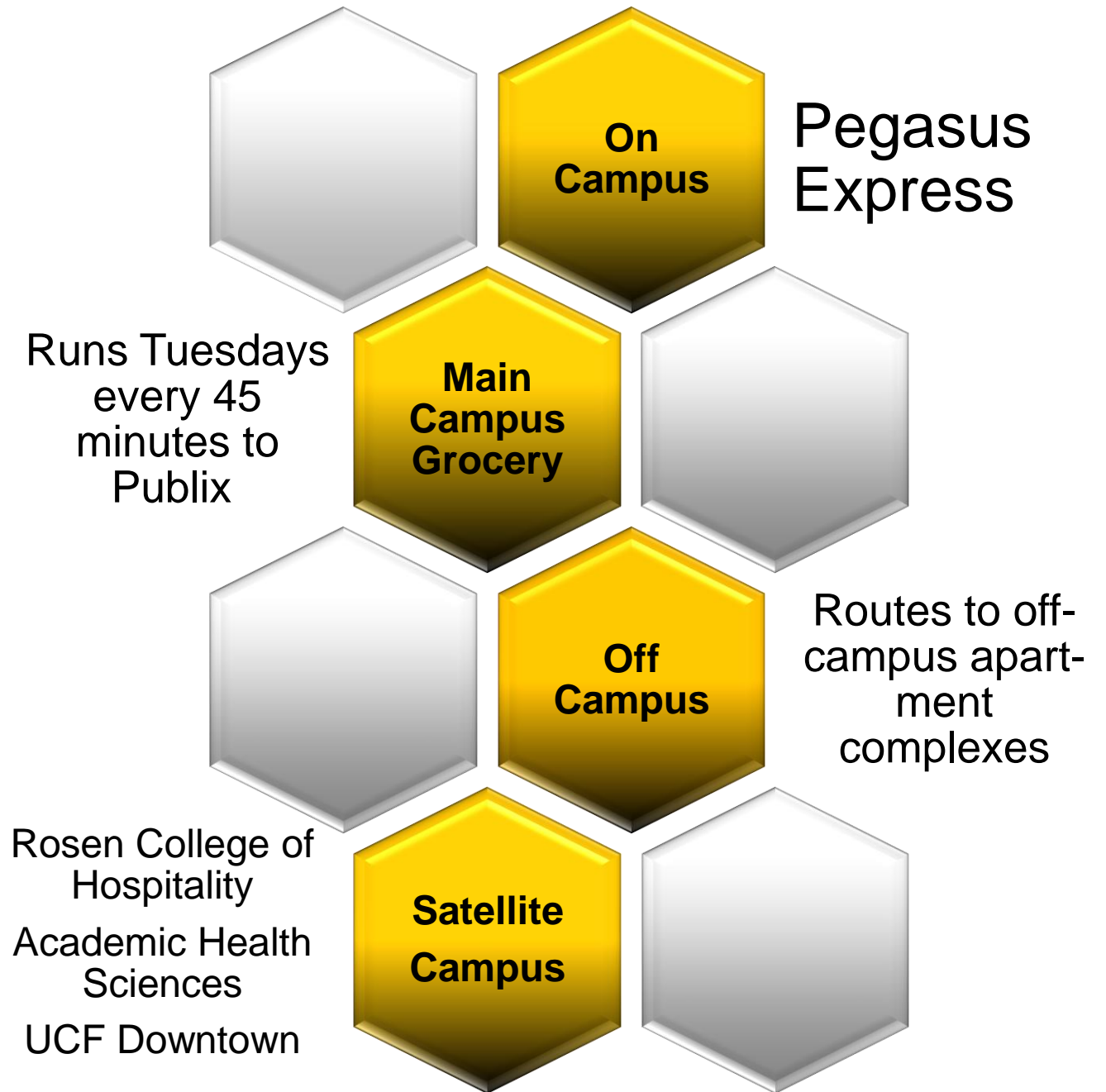


Mobile App Short cuts – Parking Availability Updates



Shuttle Service

- A valid UCF ID is required prior to boarding shuttles.
- Visit ucf.doublemap.com/map to track shuttles in real time or download the UCF Mobile app! All UCF shuttles are equipped with GPS

On-campus residents have designated parking areas relative to their housing communities.



You are required to park **Monday through Friday** between the hours of **7:00am to 5:30pm** in the designated residential parking area for your parking permit.



Main Campus & Parking Map

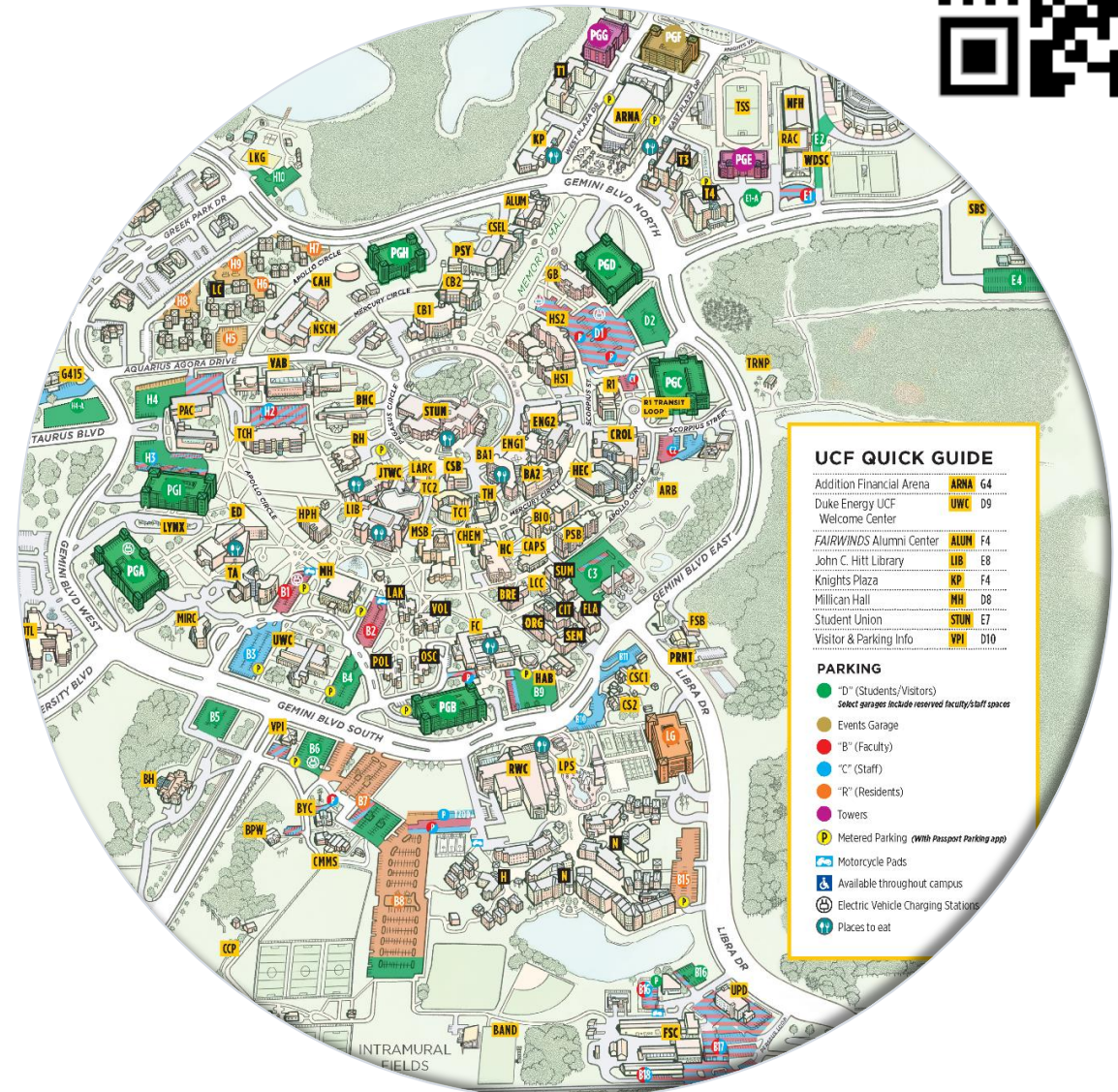


Commuting students and visitors park in **green D**.

Main Campus Housing Residents:

- **Orange LC** is for Lake Claire
Surface lots H5, H6, H7, H8, and H9
- Purple KP** is for Towers at Knights Plaza
Garages E and G
- **Orange R** is for Apollo, Libra, Hercules, Nike and Neptune
Garage Libra, surface lots B15 and B8

Vehicles with valid parking permits are allowed in **red (B)** or **blue (C)** after 5:30pm

10 Ways to Avoid Parking Citations



1 Your license plate is your parking permit. Register your license plate at parking.ucf.edu.

2 Obey all signs, pavement markings, and barricades in all lots and garages, especially ones that allow multiple permits.

3 Do not use accessible parking spaces if you do not have an accessible hangtag.

4 Do not park on the grass or sidewalk.

5 Do not park in reserved or numbered parking spaces unless it's your space. And do not block or park in service vehicle spaces.

6 Park your vehicle nose-in, license plate out.

7 Download the Passport app to pay for street parking during the required times — even if you have a parking permit.

8 Use the Pegasus Express shuttles to get around campus.

9 Arrive early. Give yourself plenty of time to find an appropriate parking space.

10 If you receive a parking citation, be prompt with your response to avoid late fees, immobilization or towing.
